

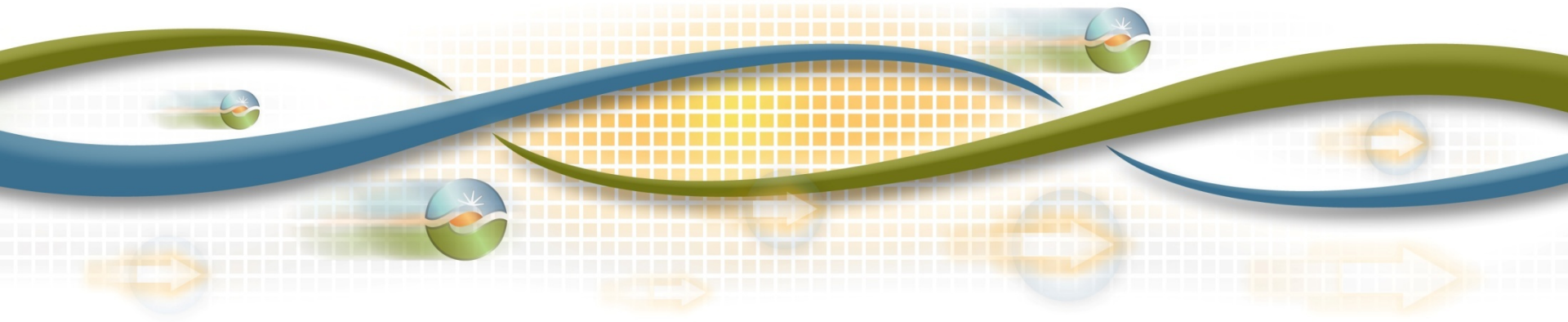

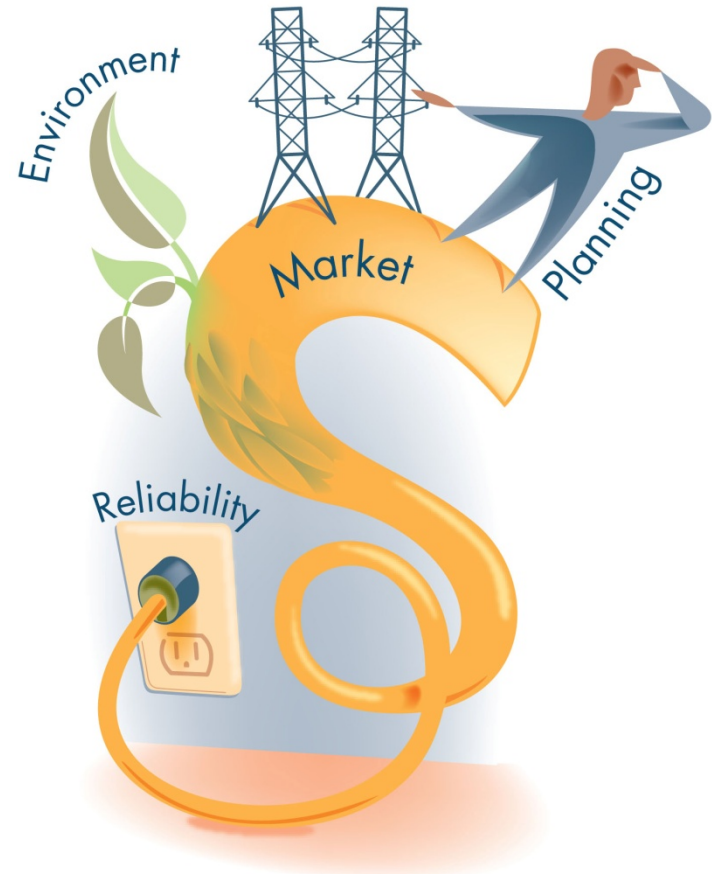


California Independent System Operator (ISO)

- Performing comprehensive **transmission planning**
- Clearing the way for **clean, green resources** to access the grid

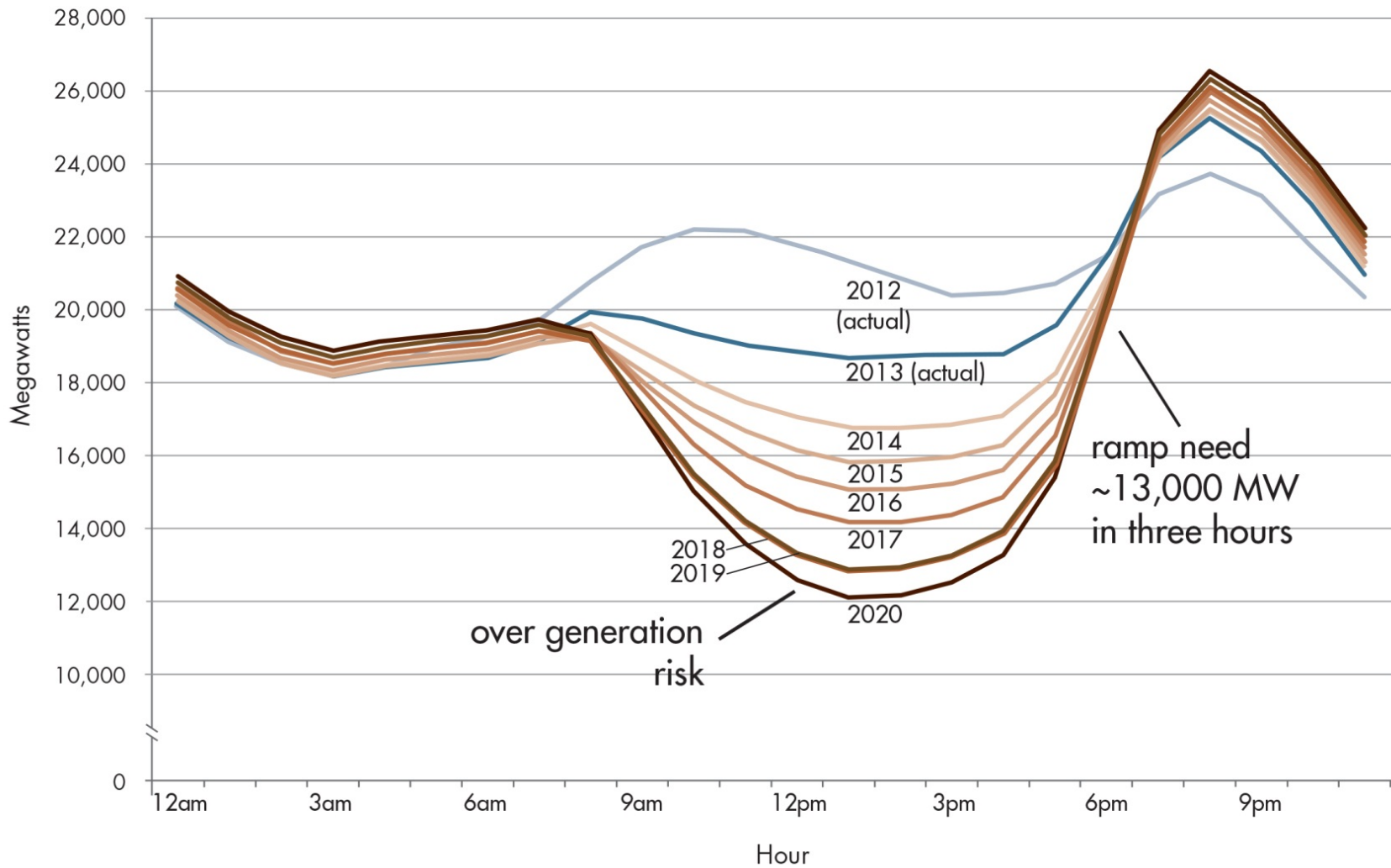


California ISO by the numbers



- **58,698** MW of power plant capacity
- **50,270** MW record peak demand (July 24, 2006)
- **26,500** market transactions per day
- **25,627** circuit-miles of transmission lines
- **30 million** people served
